

## **Papworth Hospital wins an Ovum On the Radar award for innovation in exploiting business information**

May 18, 2016 – CCube Solutions announces today that Papworth Hospital, the largest cardiothoracic centre in the country, has won an award run by leading UK IT and telecoms analysts, Ovum.

At this year's Ovum Industry Congress held in London, Papworth Hospital was recognised for the way it has installed CCube Solutions' EDRM, workflow and eForms software to create an innovative electronic medical records system (eMR) to improve how patient referral paperwork and medical notes are indexed, routed and shared among clinicians and clerical staff.

Papworth Hospital won the Innovation in Business Information category at Ovum's On the Radar Awards. Tim Jennings, Ovum's chief research officer, explains, "Our awards are all about showcasing technology innovation, highlighting the ideas, products and business models that enable end-user organisations to create real value in their businesses and help organisations become customer adaptive. The Papworth project showed just this and is why they were a category winner."

While many other trusts have digitised patient records, Papworth Hospital has taken the bold step to concentrate on the patient's pathway from the moment an individual is referred to the hospital to boost efficiency, reduce costs and enhance patient care.

All referral letters are now scanned into the eMR on arrival to make them visible to staff and show where a patient is in the booking and treatment process. Patients can be prioritised according to their needs, with two workstreams created simultaneously - an administrative pathway and a clinical pathway. Both work independently of each other.

Further to HM Treasury approval in May 2014, tertiary trust, Papworth Hospital, is building a state-of-the-art £165 million hospital on the [Cambridge Biomedical Campus](#) which will not have a paper records library on site. Therefore addressing how patient notes are managed is of paramount importance. In addition, given most referrals come from other hospitals via letter, a better system to handle this was required.

The new eReferral application went live on September 8, 2014 and was rolled out incrementally throughout the hospital. To date, 850 staff have been trained and registered to use eMR including around 120 consultants.
