

OITUK Limited trading as CCube Solutions, is committed to achieving net zero greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 2040 in line with the NHS Net Zero ambition. This commitment applies to our operations, including:

- Direct emissions (Scope 1): Emissions from sources we own or control, such as company vehicles and on-site energy consumption.
- Indirect emissions (Scope 2): Emissions from purchased electricity, heat, and cooling.
- Indirect emissions (Scope 3): Other indirect emissions associated with our activities, such as business travel, employee commuting, and purchased goods and services.

We will achieve this commitment through the following actions:

Measuring our baseline carbon footprint: We will conduct a comprehensive carbon footprint assessment to understand our current emissions across all scopes from April 2026.

Utilising renewable energy: We will utilise renewable energy solutions to meet our electricity needs where possible.

Improving energy efficiency: We will implement energy efficiency measures to reduce our energy consumption in our operations.

Reducing business travel: We will implement further strategies to reduce our business travel needs.

Engaging with suppliers: We will work with our suppliers to encourage them to reduce their own carbon footprint.

Offsetting remaining emissions: We will invest in carbon offset projects to compensate for any remaining emissions that cannot be eliminated.

We will continuously monitor our progress, report on our achievements, and review our commitment regularly. We believe that this commitment will not only help us to reduce our environmental impact but also contribute to a more sustainable future.
